Jennifer Romeo called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Motion by R. Dando, second by M. Santos, to enter into executive session at 7:01 P.M. to discuss matters of legal, personnel, and negotiations. Motion by R. Dando, second by M. Santos, to claim out of executive session at 8:05 P.M.			
Dr. Seinfeld congratulated everyone on the success of Annie the Musical and thanked Mr. Rufa. She stated that there was a full house on Sunday. Report			
Kevin Trentowski spoke on the winter athletes who were to be honored this evening. However, many athletes were attending athletic events and could not be present. Dr. Seinfeld indicated that they would be honored at the next Board Meeting.			
Dr. Seinfeld spoke on this everyone to read and atter			
Stephen Valente stated that members of BBS Architects were present to give further detail on the brick work at the High School and present a follow up to the Bond proposal. They compared the way the building is currently to the way the building would be built today. Gary Robertson reviewed the work that was done in 2011. He indicated that he had provided the Board with a report that was done at that time. He stated that a survey was completed by Ysrael A. Seinuk, PC and at that time the Board had been given a full report on these findings. The Board asked questions regarding the brick work, specifically, could all the brick work be replaced. The answer was yes, but would be at a great cost. The Board asked questions and discussed the work that needed to be done at great length. Robin Dando indicated she would like to see the brick work done in sections and continued until all areas were replaced. Dr. Seinfeld stated that some of the work could be started now using current funds, as an emergency because it is unsafe. The Board reviewed renditions of the design for the exterior of the music wing. The elevation of the building and extension were shown in these renditions. The extension will not protrude past the front of the building. The Board was pleased with the finalized rendition.			

Mr. Bob Kerr, financial advisor, spoke on his role in assisting the District with the Bond proposal. He spoke on the process; specs being sent to Albany, financial approval, bidding, and financing. He explained bonds go out to public auction. Mrs. Santos asked some questions relative to the public rate and asked that it be looked into further. Mr. Valente indicated that a resolution to refinance needs to be on the April 21 st agenda.	
Mr. Valente reviewed the 2015-2016 budget. He reviewed the budget to budget and levy to levy increases; the preliminary revenue budget, proposed expenditure budget, impact of budget (contingency) and upcoming budget dates.	
Mr. Valente stated that there was a \$0 budget gap. The proposed 2015-106 budget to budget increase was 1.37%; estimated tax levy increase 1.68%; dollar increase 549,449. He reviewed the preliminary revenues and expenditure budget, which is at a 1.37% increase. He reviewed some budget increases which included state mandated voting machines, technology equipment, Part 165 ENL, HS summer school and athletics, which include crew and football. He stated that the proposed budget would be 55,326,318.	
Mr. Valente reviewed the impact of a failed budget and the options the District has if budge did not pass on first vote; go directly to a contingency budget or a revote the third week in June. He reviewed the limitations on a contingency budget.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District hereby approves the following *Business* Resolutions as listed:

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PROPOSITION TO EXPEND CAPITAL RESERVE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District ("Board") has determined that there is a need to undertake certain capital improvements, renovations and/or alterations to District facilities ("Projects") and to purchase and acquire certain equipment, machinery or apparatus necessary for District operations ("Purchases"), to commence during the 2015-2016 school year, as described in the District's Capital Projects Summary ("Report") on file and available for public inspection in the office of the District Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that a proposition be presented to the voters of the School District authorizing the expenditure of available funds from the District's Capital Reserve Fund for that purpose, subject to any requisite SEQRA review or determinations prior to the commencement of such Projects or acquisition of such Purchases;

RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes and directs that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District at the Annual District Meeting to be held between the hours of 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. on May 19, 2015, at Oyster Bay High School; and that the District Clerk be hereby authorized and directed to give notice of such proposition to be voted at said Annual District Meeting by publishing a notice thereof, four times within the seven (7) weeks next preceding the district election, the first publication to be at least forty-five (45) days before the election, and to have the necessary ballot labels printed for said vote in the form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law and the provisions of the voting machine rules of this school district.

PROPOSITION NO. [2] (Capital Reserve Fund Expenditure Proposition):

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District ("District") is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend from the District's Capital Reserve Fund, heretofore established by the voters of the District on May 16, 2006, and amended on May 17, 2011 and May 21, 2013, an amount not to exceed Two Million Four Hundred Thirty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Five dollars (\$2,438,385) to undertake and perform school building improvement projects ("Projects") and to purchase and acquire equipment, machinery or apparatus necessary for District operations ("Purchases"), substantially as referred to and described in the District's Capital Projects Summary ("Report") on file and available for public inspection in the office of the District Clerk, all at no additional cost to District taxpayers; said Projects and Purchases to commence during the 2015-16 school year and to consist of capital improvements, renovations and/or alterations at the James Vernon School (roof replacement and fourth grade wing floor, ceiling and door repairs), the Oyster Bay High School (window replacement, science wing ceiling and lighting repair and replacement), District-wide (technology infrastructure and reconfiguration and alteration of Room 16 and associated area), Administration building (bathroom replacement); all of the foregoing to include furnishings, equipment, machinery, demolition and other work required in connection therewith, as well as preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof; provided that the detailed costs of the components of the Projects and Purchases as set forth in the Report may be reallocated among such components if the Board of Education shall determine that such reallocation is in the best interests of the District and no material change shall be made in the scope of the Projects and Purchases.
