RESOLUTION OF THE OYSTER BAY-EAST NORWICH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, NEW YORK, ADOPTED OCTOBER 6, 2015, CALLING A SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETING TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF MONEYS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES AND THE LEVY OF A TAX THEREFOR.

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE OYSTER BAY-EAST NORWICH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF NASSAU, NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A Special District Meeting of the qualified voters of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District"), shall be held within the District, on **Thursday, December 10, 2015** at 7:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Time) in the lobby of the gymnasium of the Oyster Bay High School, East Main Street, Oyster Bay, New York, as provided in the Notice calling said Special District Meeting hereinafter prescribed. The voting at such Special District Meeting shall be by voting machine, as provided by the Education Law, and the polls shall remain open from 7:00 o'clock A.M. until 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) on said day and as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters, then present, to cast their votes.

Section 2. The business to be acted upon at said Special District Meeting shall be as stated in the Notice thereof, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Notice of said Special District Meeting to be published in "*Oyster Bay Enterprise Pilot*" and "*The Guardian*," two newspapers having a general circulation in the District, such publications to be made four (4) times within the seven (7) weeks next preceding such Special District Meeting, the first publications to be at least forty-five (45) days prior to the date of said Special District Meeting.

Section 3. Said Notice of Special District Meeting shall be substantially in the following form:

(a) That the Board of Education of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to undertake a school facilities improvement project (the "Project") substantially as described in a plan prepared for the District by BBS Architects Landscape Architects and Engineers PC, (the "Plan") which is on file and available for public inspection at the office of the District Clerk; consisting of (i) the construction of art and choral room additions, the partial reconstruction and construction of alterations and improvements to existing music and art facilities, and the installation of airconditioning at the Oyster Bay High School, at the estimated cost of not to exceed \$6,990,791 and (ii) District-wide security system upgrades and enhancements, at the estimated cost of not to exceed \$826,000; the foregoing to include all original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus and ancillary or related site, demolition and other work required in connection therewith; and to expend therefor, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof, an amount not to exceed the estimated total cost of \$7,816,791; provided that the detailed costs of the components of the Project as set forth in detail in the Plan may be reallocated among such components if the Board of Education shall determine that such reallocation is in the best interests of the District:

(b) that a tax is hereby voted in the amount of not to exceed \$7,816,791 to finance such cost, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by said Board of Education; and

(c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$7,816,791 and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable.

Such Bond Proposition shall appear on the ballot labels to be inserted in the voting machines used for voting at said Special District Meeting in substantially the following condensed form: BOND PROPOSITION

RESOLVED:

(a) That the Board of Education of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District is hereby authorized to construct various additions, alterations and improvements at the Oyster Bay High School and upgrade and enhance District-wide security systems, and to expend therefor not to exceed \$7,816,791; (b) that a tax is hereby voted in the amount of not to exceed \$7,816,791 to finance such cost, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by said Board of Education; and (c) that in anticipation of said tax, bonds of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$7,816,791 and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and payable.

The voting will be conducted by ballot on voting machines as provided in the Education Law and the polls will remain open from 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 9:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) and as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their ballots

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Education Law §2014, personal registration of voters is required, and no person shall be entitled to vote at the Special District Meeting whose name does not appear on the register of the School District.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the register of the qualified voters of said School District prepared for the Annual Election held on May 19, 2015, shall be used as the basis for the preparation of the register for the Special District Meeting to be held on December 10, 2015. Any person whose name appears on such register or who shall have been previously registered for any Annual or Special District Meeting or Election and who shall have voted at any Annual or Special District Meeting or Election held or conducted at any time since January 1, 2011, will not be required to register personally for this Special District Meeting. In addition, any person otherwise qualified to vote who is registered with the Board of Elections of Nassau County under the provisions of the Election Law shall be entitled to vote at said Special District Meeting without further registration.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be applied for at the Office of the District Clerk, McCouns Lane, Oyster Bay, New York, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 4:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. If the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, the completed application must be received by the District Clerk no later than Thursday, December 3, 2015. If the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter at the office of the District Clerk, the completed application must be received by the District Clerk no later than Wednesday, December 9, 2015. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time), on Thursday, December 10, 2015.

A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the District Clerk between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 4:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Time) on each of the five (5) days prior to the day set for the Special District Meeting, except Saturday and Sunday.

Only qualified voters who are duly registered will be permitted to vote. The last day to register to vote is Friday, December 4, 2015.
