Ann Marie Longo called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Mrs. Longo indicated that the first portion of the meeting would be dedicated to a community forum with regard to the upcoming Bond Referendum Vote. She encouraged anyone who wished to speak to sign in and stated that public comments regarding the bond referendum would be received first. She reminded everyone that the bond referendum vote was on December 17th and encouraged all residents to exercise their right to vote. She stated that the community would be voting on two separate propositions; one for the work to be done at the high school and one for security upgrades throughout the District. Mrs. Longo reminded everyone why the date was changed to December 17th. She reviewed some of the needs for the work to be done in the High School music and art wing. A video was shown pointing out highlights of proposed scope of work for both propositions.

Dr. Seinfeld reminded the community that before the Board moves on to agenda items, they will take questions and comments from the community, on the proposed bond referendum. Dr. Seinfeld reviewed what enclosed entry ways to the buildings might look like if the safety proposition was passed.

Mr. Valente reviewed the costs relative to both propositions. He reviewed current funding and debt comparisons indicating the actual debt will be reduced under the new bond. Mr. Valente reviewed the tax impact of the proposed bond stating it would be an estimated \$65 a year for a residential Class 1residence based on 15/16 data. Roger Smith from BBS Architects gave some additional detail and showed some renditions of the work to be done.

Dr. Seinfeld reminded everyone that all information presented here this evening would be on the District website.

The Board asked questions relative to Mr. Valente's presentation and accepted questions and comments from the community, on the bond referendum, at this time.

Mrs. Longo introduced Liliana Policano who gave a presentation on LOTE in the 21st Century. Ms. Poliano thanked the Board and administration for the opportunity to present.

Ms. Policano reviewed useful terminology used in this presentation, some of the Board goals, and the objective of the presentation. She reviewed the current 7-12 LOTE program and 2015-2016 enrollments. She reviewed data on passing and mastery in all French and Spanish classes and some of the program enhancements. Ms. Policano reviewed some future possibilities for the LOTE program, including adding early language K-6 FLES and additional program enhancements, stating she would like to see the program grow.

The Board asked questions relative to Ms. Policano's presentation. The Board indicated they would like additional information regarding the future possibilities of a K-6 FLES program. The Board asked for a review of the curriculum to enrich or change if needed. They asked Ms. Policano to report back to the Board with some options and dollar amounts.

Dr. Seinfeld asked the Board if they had any questions regarding the budget timeline presentation that was included in their packet. There were no questions.
