Additional Security Initiatives In Place as of January and February 2016



- Lead security hired January 13, 2016
- 10 security guards interviewed and hired
- Orientation completed February 3, 2016
- Uniforms are in the process of being purchased
- All security personnel will be assigned Motorola radios
- Security team guide/procedures completed
- Duties and responsibilities to include: greeting visitors, daily inspection of inner and outer perimeter of school(foot patrol), assist in arrival and dismissal of students.
- Parking and traffic assessments completed (report to BOE on March 15th)

Additional Security Initiatives In Place as of January and February 2016 (cont.

- 2 security guards will be assigned at the High School during school day and at all events at night/weekends that are school related.
- Vernon and Roosevelt schools will have one security guard assigned during the day. There will also be a one security guard assigned during any night activities.
- Security personnel will be assigned to schools starting February 22, 2016
- Lockdown drills to be held at buildings with Security staff and Nassau County Police POP unit in early Spring
