J. Romeo called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm.

Mr. Cronin introduced Steven Keehner of Oyster Bay High School, who led the community in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dr. Seinfeld introduced Peter Rufa, Supervisor, Fine & Performing Arts. Mr. Rufa told the audience that tonight they will have a special preview of OBHS musical production of "You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown". Students performed a musical number for the Board and community. Mr. Rufa also recognized OBEN students who were the 2016 Agapae Gold Medal recipients of the Columbia Scholastic Press Association as well as students who participated in the Nassau All County Art Exhibition. Mr. Rufa gave special thanks to the collaborative effort of the English and Art departments. Special recognition was given to Patrick Conway, a senior at OBHS. Patrick was a Long Island's Best Student Art Winner and an Art League of Long Island, Advanced Placement Artist.

Dr. Seinfeld introduced Kevin Trentowski, Athletic Director. Mr. Trentowski recognized the 2016-2017 Winter All County/County Champions. Special recognition was given to Keith Cassar, a junior at OBHS. Keith received All County and All State honors in wrestling.

Dr. Castellano stated there were two pieces of correspondence received by the Board of Education.

J. Romeo called for the approval of the Business Meeting minutes held on 2/7/17. Minutes were approved.

Linda Ninesling gave the treasurer's report for the month of February, 2017. The treasurer's report was accepted.
