STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT (SED) APPROVAL PROCESS:



- VOTERS APPROVE CAPITAL RESERVE PROJECTS IN MAY OF 2017.
- STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT (SEQRA)
 REVIEW MUST BE COMPLETED.
- PLANS AND SPECS FOR THE PROJECTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO SED.
- SED APPROVAL TIME IS NOW APPROXIMATELY 22 WEEKS.
- AFTER SED APPROVAL, THE PROJECTS MUST BE BID.
- ACTUAL WORK FOR PROJECTS BY THE VOTERS IN MAY OF 2017 WILL NOT COMMENCE UNTIL THE SUMMER OF 2018.

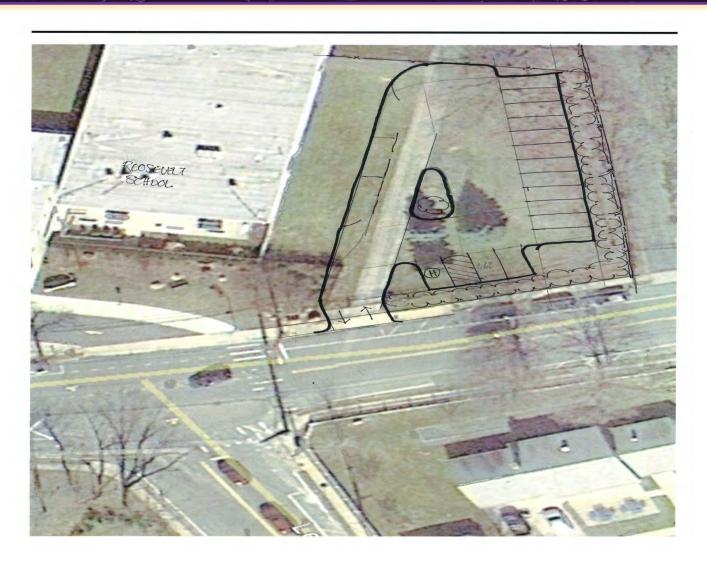

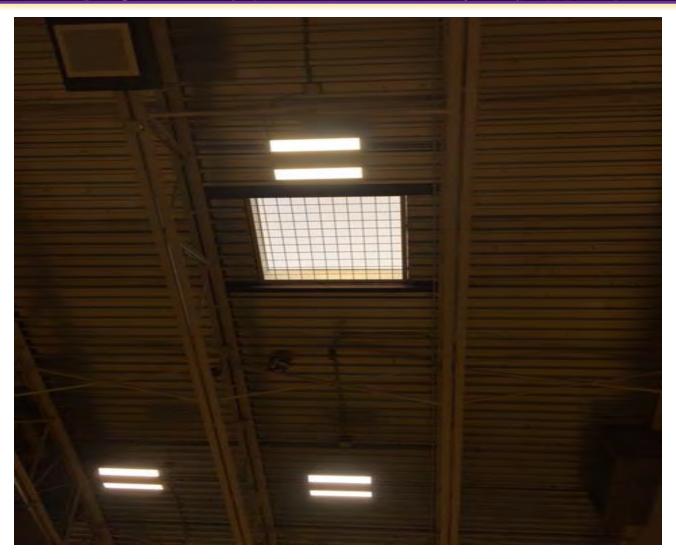

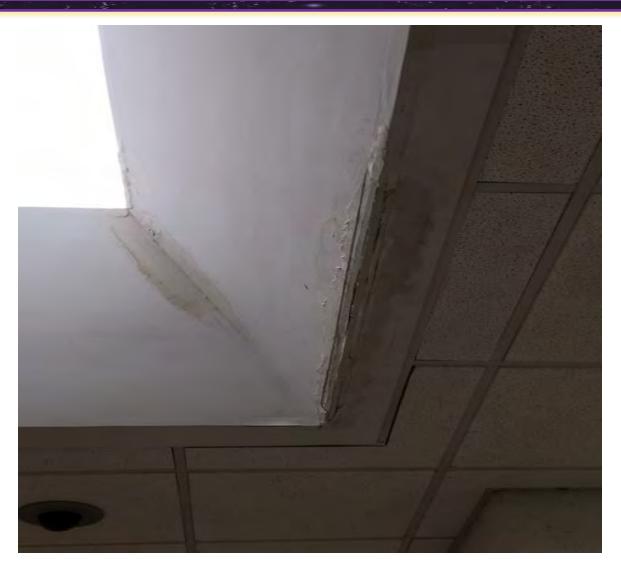

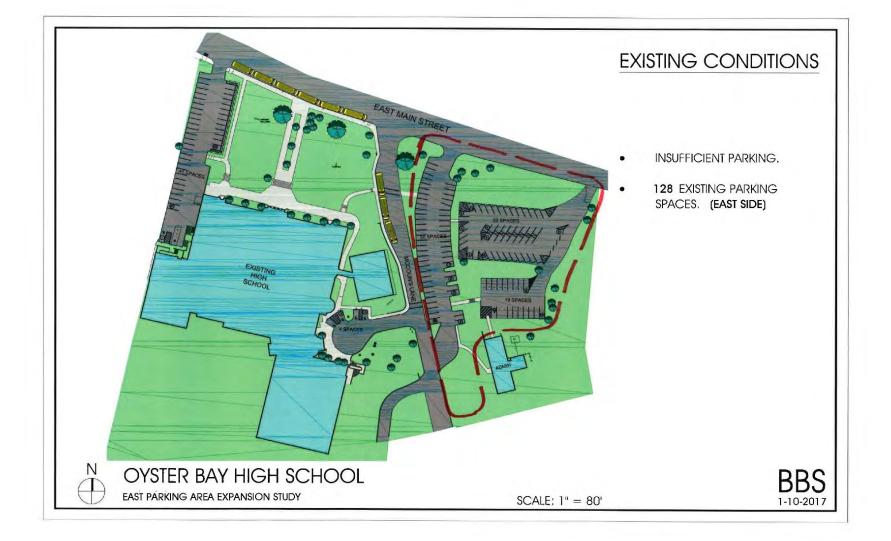

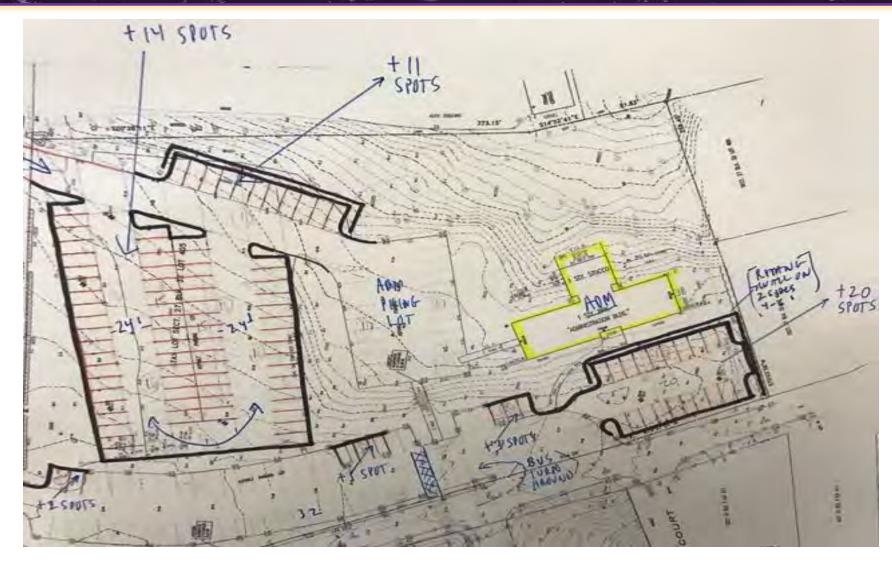

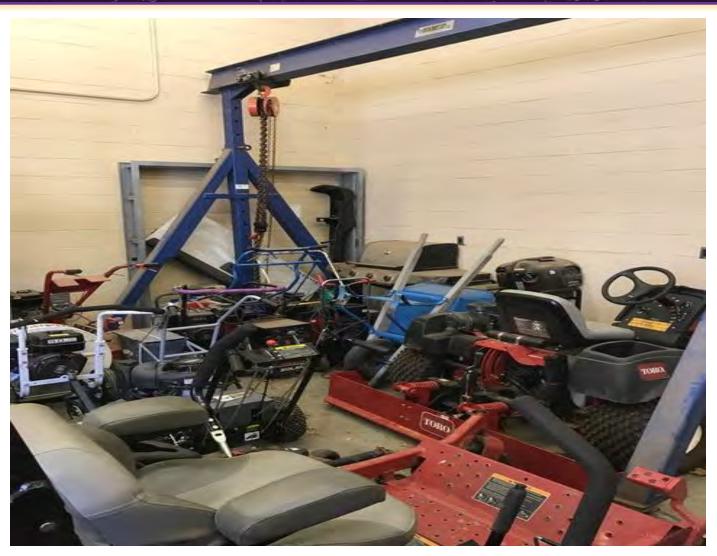

CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FACTS:



- MAXIMUM CAPITALIZATION THRESHOLD OF \$20 MILLION.
- THE TERM OF THE FUND IS UNTIL JUNE 30, 2026.
- TERMS AND THRESHOLDS CAN BE MODIFIED THROUGH A VOTER APPROVED PROPOSITION AT ANY TIME.
- ANNUAL VOTER APPROVAL IS REQUIRED FOR NEW CAPITAL RESERVE PROJECTS.

CAPITAL RESERVE REFERENDUM FACTS:



- PUBLIC NOTICE MUST BE IN THE NEWSPAPERS OF RECORD (ENTERPRISE PILOT AND THE GUARDIAN) AT LEAST 45 DAYS PRIOR TO THE BUDGET VOTE.
- AS A RESULT, ALL PROJECTS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD BY MARCH 7, 2017.
