There was discussion of indicators for college and career readiness, SAT and ACT results as well as identifying career clusters.

Mr. McEvoy and Mr. Cronin were also in attendance as they are members of the District Safety Team. There was an update on the construction of new vestibules, the visitor management system, lock down and fire drills and an update on security personnel. There was Board discussion of the elimination of crossing guards at Rte. 106 and 25A.

There was Board discussion of the 2017 Proposed Resolutions for the Annual NYSSBA Business Meeting to be held on October 14, 2017 in Lake Placid, NY.
