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Current Transportation



Overall summary of program at current 1.25 mileage limit:

- Approximately 45 vehicles (regular, special education & non-public)
- 3-year average cost = \$2.6 million aided at 6.5% minimum from NYSED
- Large bus \$70,000-80,000 annually van \$35,000-45,000 annually
- Contract amounts increased annually using May Consumer Price Index

Mileage limit changed via public referendum only

Current Transportation Cont.

- Mileage limit is 1.25 miles from each building i.e. only students residing further away than 1.25 miles from their current building are eligible for bussing
- Approximately 56% of students are currently eligible for transportation
- All transportation routes are updated annually based upon current demographics
- Busses are routed for efficiency, however District allows extra room to accommodate athletic equipment and musical instruments
- Hendrickson accommodates all transportation routes (regular, special education, non-public, athletics, etc.)

Ridership Study



Hendrickson recently performed a study to count riders and District overlaid this information with assigned riders to calculate average ridership.

Estimated Cost Review



Estimated additional costs if transportation limits were adjusted in the following scenarios:

- Universal (all-ride) bussing at elementary level TR & JV only:
 - 3-5 additional buses, approximately \$240,000-400,000
- Universal (all-ride) bussing district-wide:
 - 6-8 additional buses, approximately \$480,000-640,000
- Reduce limit to 1.0 mile district-wide:
 - 3 additional buses, approximately \$240,000
- Reduce limit to 1.0 mile at elementary level TR & JV only:
 - 2-3 additional buses, approximately \$160,000-240,000

Items for Consideration



- All previous estimates based on current demographics
- "Clustering" of students
- Longer bus routes
- Possible re-bid of contract, increased costs?
- Recurring annual costs also added fuel costs
- Mileage limit changed via pubic referendum only
- Tax cap implications
