Todd Cronin called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Motion by N. Castrogiovanni, second by M. Santos, to enter into executive session. Motion by R. Dando, second by M. Santos, to claim out of executive session at 7:35 P.M.

Maryann Santos reported on correspondence received by the Board.

Dr. Seinfeld reminded everyone to come out and support the homecoming game which will be October 12<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Seinfeld spoke on the residency verification that has been taking place. Dr. Seinfeld read a statement where she provided the Board with a reminder of a new policy that was adopted in January. She referred to this policy and discussed what the changes were. Dr. Seinfeld indicated that the policy was adopted so that the Board could confirm that only students living within the Oyster Bay – East Norwich CSD are attending school here. She reviewed the multiple ways the District has contacted families who had not yet complied. Dr. Seinfeld stated that the District had spoken with legal counsel with respect to the ramifications for those that did not comply with the verification process. Legal counsel indicated that students cannot be out of school while this process is taking place. Dr. Seinfeld reviewed the process if there is a concern that a student who is believed to not be living in the school District and is attending school here. The Board asked questions on residency and registration. Maryanne Sadowski reviewed what other local districts do regarding registration and re-verification.

Motion by R. Dando, second by J. McEvoy, to approve the minutes from the meetings of August 6<sup>th</sup> and August 21, 2019. The minutes were approved.

Dr. Mulhall thanked the Board for their support in the technology department. She stated that although there was a slight delay, last week they were able to distribute Chromebooks to grades 7 and 9. She stated that third grade had also received devices and thanked the technology department for their work in getting these to students.

Michael Cipriani gave the Board a brief update on the transportation referendum and the reduction of mileage to 0.5 for high school students and universal for elementary students. Mr. Cipriani gave the timeline for legal publication and deadlines if the Board were to put out a transportation referendum vote.

Mr. Cipriani suggested the middle of January to allow for time to work with Hendrickson to review what this would mean relative to additional buses and cost, if applicable. If there is no additional cost, the referendum could be put up at the May vote.

The Board accepted questions and comments from the community, on agenda items, at this time.
