



COMPARING GRADES 3-8 MATHEMATICS ASSESSMENT DATA



Refusal Rates for ELA & Math







Moving Forward

- Increase participation in 3-8 assessments by 10%
- Increase number of AP exams where OBEN outperforms the region
 - 2019 (Out-performed the region in 9/16 exams)
 - 2020 (Out-perform the region in 11/16 exams)
 - 2021 (Out-perform the region in 13/16 exams)
- Increase number of Regents exams where OBEN outperforms the region
 - 2019 (Out-performed the region in 6/10 exams)
 - 2020 (Out-perform the region in 8/10 exams)
 - 2021 (Out-perform the region in 10/10 exams)

Moving Forward

- Prepare for changes in science and social studies exams
 - June 2020 (New US History, 2nd administration of New Global exam)
 - Align Curriculum for roll-out of new science exams beginning June 2021
- Continue to provide support to teachers who are teaching AP courses for the first time
