


Building the Budget

BUDGET SUMMARY REVENUES

State Aid – funds provided by the State

Approximately 3.4 million ~ 5.5% of Annual Budget

Other Revenues – funds obtained by reserves and fund balance

Approximately 3.2 million ~ 5.1% of Annual Budget

Tax Levy – funds obtained by residents

Approximately 55.5 million ~ 89.4% of Annual Budget
