


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Counseling Department

Highlights of our robust academic offerings include:

BUSINESS

The business department is an essential component of the academic program of Oyster Bay High School. The curriculum is intrinsically related to many academic areas, affording students the opportunity to apply knowledge gained in other disciplines. Students are taught relevant computer-based skills that can be applied in their educational, professional and personal lives. Students who have completed or are scheduled to complete three full credits in business education may apply for membership in the New York State Business and Marketing Honor Society.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

Computer science and technology are essential components of high school education. Learning computer science empowers young people to compete in the global economy and pursue a variety of careers as it teaches students computational thinking and problem-solving skills applicable in any industry. The computer science department at Oyster Bay High School equips students with the concepts and critical thinking skills necessary to meet the global challenges of the present and future.





ENGLISH

The Oyster Bay High School English Department is committed to cultivating our young scholars' curiosity. Through the study of authors' divergent perspectives and treatments of universal themes, our young scholars, armed with an ever-increasing understanding of rhetoric, grapple with ideas, conduct research, explore their own underlying assumptions, refine and share their perspectives, practice dialogue and engender in themselves the habits of empathic, informed citizens. We aim to equip our students with the creative and critical thinking skills necessary to thrive beyond high school as creators and consumers of content in a society transformed by the globalization and democratization of information sharing.


The department offers a range of courses that support students' research skills and journalism interests, including Humanities Research. In this course students explore topics of interest across disciplines and take informed action by researching and investigating civic issues and developing strategies and solutions. Unique electives such as History and Literature Through Games are also offered, which allow students to apply their knowledge of board and computerized games to conduct research and comparative studies of historical themes and figures as well as literary analysis.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The health and physical education department of Oyster Bay-East Norwich contributes to each student's growth and development in a movement-based curriculum incorporating the psychomotor, affective and cognitive domains. Teachers deliver a planned, sequential K-12 instructional program that aids students in attaining levels of skill development that allow them to participate competently in physical activities.

Our students are educated in a caring, safe environment that provides successful experiences for all students. We instill an appreciation for physical activity and wellness and promote the "joy of effort" while providing an element of challenge and enjoyment through participation. Our program develops positive social skills and attitudes including independence, responsibility, leadership, cooperation, fair play, teamwork and respect among students and staff.

The physical education program at Oyster Bay-East Norwich prides itself on offering our students numerous opportunities to meet the New York State graduation requirements through electives such as Mindfulness, Weight Training, and Exercise Science. The physical education curriculum in Oyster Bay-East Norwich is based on national standards and the New York State Learning Standards.





MATHEMATICS

The mathematics department strives to provide our students with the type of learning required in a 21st-century classroom. Aligned with the District vision, our math courses provide students with the rigor of mathematics, show the relevance and role of mathematics in their learning and allow students to develop learning relationships with their peers and teachers. Our teachers assist students in cultivating their critical thinking and problem-solving skills, communicating their understanding and fostering collaboration with their peers. In our math classes, students study the overarching topics of number and quantity, algebra, functions, geometry, statistics and probability, and calculus. Students not only develop their procedural fluency in mathematics, but they also deepen their

conceptual understanding, model and apply mathematics, and use technology as a tool to enhance their learning.

SCIENCE

The science department encourages students to master skills and concepts across the disciplines of life, earth and physical science. Our department encourages four years of high school science for all, offering a variety of electives and Advanced Placement courses to meet the diverse needs and interests of our students. Students regularly design and perform experiments, enabling them to gain practical laboratory knowledge and skills. Opportunities for field studies, guest lecturers and authentic data collection strengthen student learning throughout various coursework.

SOCIAL STUDIES

The commencement-level social studies program builds upon the previous knowledge, skills and aptitudes developed in our K-8 program that are essential for students to become responsible citizens in our multicultural society and interdependent world. The social studies department provides a variety of programs to satisfy the requirement of four credits of social studies for a Regents or Advanced Regents Diploma. In addition to required credits and courses necessary for graduation, students may choose a variety of electives in the social sciences. Oyster Bay High School was a pilot school in the year of 2022-23 for the Seal of Civic Readiness. By participating in individual and small group projects focused on civic knowledge, civic skills, civic mindset and civic experience, students can earn a formal recognition on their diploma signifying that they have attained a high level of proficiency in these areas.

WORLD LANGUAGES

Students in the Oyster Bay-East Norwich world language program learn to communicate effectively in a new language and demonstrate the cultural competency necessary to interact with people from other cultures. We are proud to offer a variety of world languages courses starting with the FLES

Chinese Mandarin in grade 5, further exploring Mandarin Chinese, French and Spanish during grade 6, and expanding all three languages with the addition of ASL in grades 7-12. All of our students have the opportunity to reach the Advanced Placement and college dual enrollment-level world language courses, as well as an opportunity to graduate with the New York State Seal of Biliteracy in English and a world language.

ENGLISH AS A NEW LANGUAGE (ENL)

English language learners enrolled in the ENL program acquire and learn effective basic interpersonal communication skills and achieve cognitive academic language proficiency in English so that they may take full advantage of all the available academic and extracurricular programs, prepare for future higher educational opportunities and careers, graduate with the New York State Seal of Biliteracy in English and their home language, and potentially reach multiliteracy should they choose to study another world language and earn the seal in multiple languages. Our ENL program provides co-taught classes across all disciplines, empowering students to achieve excellence in all academic areas.

Music and the Arts

The Oyster Bay-East Norwich School District offers robust programs in the arts for children in each of our three schools. We are proud to offer a renowned performing arts program that begins at the elementary level, where we have introduced an expanded repertoire of music opportunities including a new strings program (districtwide) and a high school TV Production & Multimedia Journalism Program, with a state-of-the-art TV studio set to launch in Spring 2024.

The high school music department offers courses that encourage self-expression and promote skills for analyzing, critiquing and appreciating music. Students at Oyster Bay High School take their fine, media and performing arts classes in our beautiful Fine and Performing Arts Wing that debuted in 2019. We are also excited to announce that a brand-new music building has started to be built at Vernon, our 3-6 building. Students in our department develop interpersonal skills and self-confidence as they prepare for and participate in culminating experiences. Along with biannual performances at the stunning Oyster Bay High School Performance Center, our high school musicians have performed in concerts on the stages of Carnegie Hall, Radio City Music Hall and Madison Square Garden and in collaboration with the NYC Master Chorale. Each year, we are proud of the large number of students who are designated as All-County musicians.

Our innovative fine arts program is recognized for incorporating traditional fine arts skills with cutting-edge multimedia software. At the high school, the art department offers an array of courses that encourage self-expression and promote skills for analyzing, critiquing and appreciating the arts. The program cultivates students' interests through a variety of media and prepares them for advanced study or careers in the visual arts.

Innovation and Technology

Innovation and technology at Oyster Bay are integral parts of our students' lives, contributing to a collaborative environment and providing them with **valuable skills to succeed in the 21st century.** Throughout all grade levels, students are afforded numerous hands-on experiences with real-world applications. We are confident that this will yield tremendous results in preparing our students for postsecondary education and fieldwork.

Beginning with a coding and robotics curriculum for students in grades K-6 and continuing to high school, where students can take courses in computer programming, coding and architectural engineering, Oyster Bay-East Norwich is at the forefront of engineering education on Long Island.

Ultimately, students are learning to think critically, which promotes real-world problemsolving skills and prepares them for the next phase of their lives.



High School Library and Media Center

The Oyster Bay High School Library offers students a truly unique learning experience. The physical space itself is like no other high school library in Nassau County. Its high ceiling and painted steel girders make it a truly inspirational space. The library provides access to college-level research databases such as JSTOR and Proquest, and provides 24-hour access to countless e-books and audiobooks via Sora. To encourage students to create innovative research projects, the library has two 3-D printers, digital cameras and video recording devices available. And with two new innovation labs opening shortly within the library, students will have additional spaces to collaborate amongst their peers and faculty.



Student Life

The district's academic program is enhanced by a wide range of extracurricular programs that support our students' variety of interests. Through their involvement in various clubs and activities, our students develop vital leadership and communication skills that they carry with them upon graduation.

School Counseling

We are extremely proud of our school counseling services, which provide a range of services for students in grades K-12. In addition to supporting students in the areas of social-emotional learning and well-being, our counseling staff is vital in the college matriculation process for our high school students. Through their guidance, our high school students and families are able to better navigate the college application and financial aid process. Students are assigned an experienced school counselor upon their arrival to Oyster Bay High School in seventh grade and continue with the same counselor until grade 12. This allows ample time for formative relationships to be built, allowing our students to receive individual guidance in achieving their postsecondary goals.
