Laurie Kowalsky called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Motion by N. Castrogiovanni, second by T. Cronin to enter executive session.

Motion by T. Cronin, second by N. Castrogiovanni to claim out of executive session at 7:32 PM.

Motion by T. Cronin, second by D. Gerbosi to remove item 1A from Agenda since District Clerk is present at meeting.

Dr. Ianni began his Superintendent's report by recognizing several students for their athletic accomplishments. He went on to speak of OBEN's successful STEM week celebration for Grades Pre-K through 12 which involved coding, science & engineering activities. Further, Dr. Ianni congratulated HS Health & PE Teacher, Charlie Rizzuto who was named by SHAPE America as Physical Education Teacher of the Year.

Dr. Ianni gave a brief update on capital projects indicating the completion of work at the HS (gymnasium AC), Vernon (casework) and TR schools (bathroom renovation & cubby/shelving work).

Dr. Ianni gave an update on the Legislative Committee meeting and Academic Committee meeting that were held recently. The Legislative Committee met with Senator Gaughran in December. Some of the topics discussed with the Senator were Covid 19 vaccination & testing, legislative grants and state aid. The committee also discussed parental concerns that a Covid 19 mandate may cause a sizable number of students enrolled in public education to pursue other types of schooling. The Senator reassured the committee that at the time of the meeting (December 19th), he did not see that a mandate would gain traction in the Senate. Dr. Ianni indicated that Senator Gaughran understood the potential impact that required testing would have on the school community. He thanked the Board members that attended the meeting and reiterated that the District benefits from proactive and collaborative relationships with the Senator and Legislators. The Academic Committee meetings were held twice in the fall. Dr. Ianni stated that the committee determined that a minor restructuring of the college essay class in junior year will

benefit students and help them in terms of the college application process. Other topics of discussion included upcoming community events to promote schools, elementary counseling, benchmarking, and AP Exams.

Dr. Ianni welcomed a new part-time business teacher that will be appointed by the Board this evening, Ms. Alexis Zaino. He then introduced Mr. Bramoff, Athletic Director who spoke on the Student Athletic Achievements, Girls & Boys' Cross-Country Post-Season Awards, All Conference and All County:

Ms. Rachel Greene gave an update on the Mandarin program and began by thanking Ms. Yiming Wang for her energy, creativity and enthusiasm in the classroom. Currently 6th grade students have 30-minute sessions of Mandarin built into their instructional day. At the HS, 7th graders have one section of Mandarin 1A. All learning activities are interactive/task oriented & target language is used. Mandarin topics from January to June will include Chinese New Year Celebration, Chinese art/games, occupations, and daily routines. A video was shown of Vernon students speaking Mandarin. Going forward 2022-2023, all 6th grade students will take Mandarin, 7th grade will take Mandarin 1A and 8th grade will take Mandarin 1B.

Ms. Kowalsky asked about the amount of time the 6th graders receive for Mandarin and Ms. Greene confirmed that it is 30 minutes.

Mr. Femino gave an update on the Orchestra program at Vernon. Highlights include, program growth, additional 4th grade cohort and debut of first live performance in December. It's expected that there will be an increase in NYSSMA participation this year. In the 2022-2023 school year, 80 students are projected to be involved in Vernon Orchestra. Also, looking ahead, with expected capital improvement projects, there will be more rehearsal space and more participation in county wide programs. A recording of the elementary orchestra was shown from the December concerts.

Ms. Castrogiovanni thanked Mr. Femino for bringing this program to OBEN students.

Dr. Ianni gave an update to the 21st century capital improvements. He again thanked the community for support of the Bond. He reiterated that updates on the process will be posted on the District website and he encouraged the community to check it frequently and to follow social media for updates. The general process moving forward includes design, submission to the State, approval from the State (minimum time 4-6 weeks) procurement, awarding of contracts and ordering of material. See presentation for detail on planning process, financing, and timeline. Currently, OBEN is in preparation for the 1st of 3 phases of the timeline. Dr. Ianni stated that the goal is to complete the capital improvement project on time and on budget.

VI BOND CERTIFICATION

BOND RESOLUTION OF OYSTER BAY-EAST NORWICH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JANUARY 11, 2022, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALTERATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO DISTRICT BUILDINGS AND/OR THE SITES THEREOF; STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$29,971,202; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFOR; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$29,971,202 SERIAL BONDS OF SAID DISTRICT TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION.

Recital

WHEREAS, at the Special District Meeting duly called and held on December 7, 2021, in Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District, in the County of Nassau, New York (the "District"), a majority of the qualified voters present and voting approved a Bond Proposition authorizing the construction of alterations and improvements to District buildings and/or the sites thereof; and such qualified voters then present and voting further authorized the Board of Education to levy and collect a tax to be collected in annual installments to pay the principal of and interest on the \$29,971,202 serial bonds authorized to be issued; Now, therefore,

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF OYSTER BAY-EAST NORWICH CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE COUNTY OF NASSAU, NEW YORK, HEREBY RESOLVES (by the favorable vote of not less than two-thirds of all the members of said Board of Education) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District, in the County of Nassau, New York, is hereby authorized to construct alterations and improvements to District buildings and/or the sites thereof, substantially as described in the plan prepared by the District with the assistance of BBS Architects, Landscape Architects, & Engineers, P.C., including (as and where required): building additions to provide for new classroom, music and cafeteria space; interior reconstruction and space reconfiguration; improvements to the heating, air conditioning, lighting, drainage, fire safety, public address, and security systems; the construction of a storage building; window and door enhancements; entryway façade improvements; and the construction of athletic playing field and other recreation improvements; the foregoing to include the original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus and ancillary or related site, demolition and other work required in connection therewith. The estimated maximum cost thereof, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and to the financing thereof, is \$29,971,202 and said amount is hereby appropriated therefor. The plan of finance includes the issuance of \$29,971,202 serial bonds of the District to finance said appropriation, and the levy and collection of taxes on all the taxable real property in the District to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and payable.

Section 2. Serial bonds of the District in the amount of \$29,971,202 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (herein called "Law") to finance said appropriation.

Section 3. The following additional matters are hereby determined and declared:

- (a) The period of probable usefulness applicable to the purpose for which serial bonds are authorized to be issued pursuant to this resolution, within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 97 of the Law, is thirty (30) years.
- (b) The proceeds of the bonds herein authorized and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds may be applied to reimburse the District for expenditures made for the purpose or purposes for which said bonds are authorized. The foregoing statement of intent with respect to reimbursement is made in conformity with Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 of the United States Treasury Department.

Section 4. Each of the bonds authorized by this resolution and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds shall contain the recital of validity as prescribed by Section 52.00 of the Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the District, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the District without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the District are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds and provision shall be made annually in the budget of the District by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the bonds and any notes in anticipation thereof to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of this resolution and of the Law and pursuant to the provisions of Section 21.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, Section 30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes and Section 50.00 and Sections 56.00 to 60.00 of the Law, the powers and duties of the Board of Education relative to authorizing bond anticipation notes and prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of all bonds herein and heretofore authorized and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, and the renewals of said bond anticipation notes, are hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education, the chief fiscal officer of the District.

Section 6. The validity of the bonds authorized by this resolution, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

- a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the District is not authorized to expend money, or
- b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of such resolution, or a summary hereof, are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
- c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

Section 7. This bond resolution shall take effect immediately, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish the foregoing resolution, in summary, together with a Notice attached in substantially the form prescribed by §81.00 of the in *The Enterprise Pilot* and *The Oyster Bay Guardian*, two newspapers each having a general circulation within the District and hereby designated the official newspapers of said District for such publication.

At this time the Board took questions and comments from the community on non-agenda items.

Dr. Ianni commented that the mask mandate was renewed in accordance to the law and reiterated that it is a mandate – not a determination. Further, he stated that counties do not have the authority to require School Boards to vote on specific issue or to provide direction on mandates. Dr. Ianni stated that at this point this issue is not about courage – it's about following the law and the District is being advised by school Attorney's to follow the law. He reiterated he has the best interest of the students in mind.

Ms. Kowalsky stated that District's Attorney's have advised us to follow the law and not doing so would be to risk going remote among other things.

Dr. Ianni stated that he specifically asked school Attorney's if the mandate was temporary and if it was renewed in accordance with the law and he was advised that it was.

Ms. Santos stated that we have been advised by our Attorney's that it is not within our local control to make a decision on mask mandate. The Board is going to adhere to the advice of the school Attorney. Dr. Ianni recommends to the school Board that we follow the mask mandate.

Ms. Castrogiovanni asked that the public refrain from profanity.

Ms. Santos stated that Dr. Ianni gave a report at the beginning of tonight's meeting about the Legislative Committee meeting that was held with Senator Gaughran and the result was that there was no initiative before the legislature to mandate vaccines.

Dr. Ianni stated there is a law that is loud and clear which is that there is a mask mandate and if he breaks the law he cannot advocate for the students. He also stated that regarding a vaccine mandate, the Legislative Committee clearly expressed parental concerns at the December 19th meeting with Senator Gaughran who stated that there is no traction towards a vaccine mandate at the time of the meeting.

Ms. Santos clarified that the Board took the initiative to be in front of a vaccine mandate bill in the Legislative Committee meeting with Senator Gaughran and reiterated that the Board was assured there was no traction in the Senate towards a vaccine mandate bill. Further, she stated, if there was ever a concern of a change, the Committee would certainly reach out again to Senator Gaughran.
